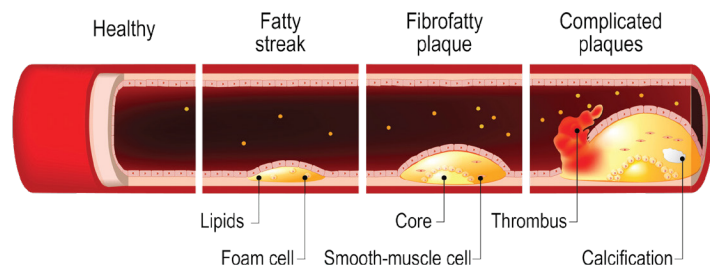


CARDIAC CT CALCIUM SCORING



McLaren Central Michigan now offers CT calcium scoring scanning, used to help determine the amount of calcium in the arteries surrounding the heart.

The cardiac CT scan can determine if coronary artery disease (CAD) is present and to what extent to reduce the risks of a heart attack. This screening may be recommended by a physician for patients with risk factors for CAD but who have no clinical symptoms.

RISK FACTORS:

Men and women age 45 and older who do not have a history of coronary artery disease but have one or more risk factors, including:

- Family history of heart disease
- Cigarette smoking
- Overweight or obese
- Sedentary lifestyle
- High LDL cholesterol
- Low HDL cholesterol
- High blood pressure
- Diabetes

While this test is typically not covered by insurance, it is available as a self-pay option for \$150.
